Howdy Partners!

With a long hot summer behind us - I'm looking forward to the fall with all the beautiful leaves and cooler weather. As always, it is my pleasure to be of assistance to our members. In case I don't see some of you before Thanksgiving and Christmas enjoy your holidays and travel safe !

Just a few reminders to make this season enjoyable for everyone:

- ** Do not go the WRONG WAY on the one-way roads.
- ** Speed limit is 10 MPH-all golf cart drivers must have a valid drivers license.
- ** Alcohol should remain inside your camper, rental unit or cabin.
- ** Quiet Time is 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

** Absolutely no parking on the street or the grass. Guests must use the overflow parking area.

- ** RV's cannot be abandoned overnight. RV's must be occupied each evening.
- ** Pets must be on a leash at all times. We are not a "Bank", so please don't allow your pet to leave a deposit. It is your responsibility to clean up after your pet.
- ** Reservations can be made 60 days in advance of your arrival date. A 48 Hour cancellation fee of \$50.00 will be applied if you do not notify us or leave a message on the office answering machine at least 48 hours in advance of your arrival.
- ** Motorized bicycles, scooter and mopeds must be operated by a licensed driver.
- ** Bicycle riders MUST wear helmets and use EXTREME CAUTION when riding near the entrance of campground due to heavy traffic flow. PARENTS please be AWARE of where your children are riding at all times!
- ** GRAFFITTI-Anyone caught writing graffiti on any property of Horseshoe Trails will be ESCORTED/BANNED from park until appearing before the Board of Directors.
- ** Tarps are not allowed hanging from awnings of campers or Motorhomes
- ** Horseshoe Trails Grills are to be used for cooking only, not as a fire ring !!!
- ** Deep cleaning fee's on cabins & RV rentals has increased to \$100.00
